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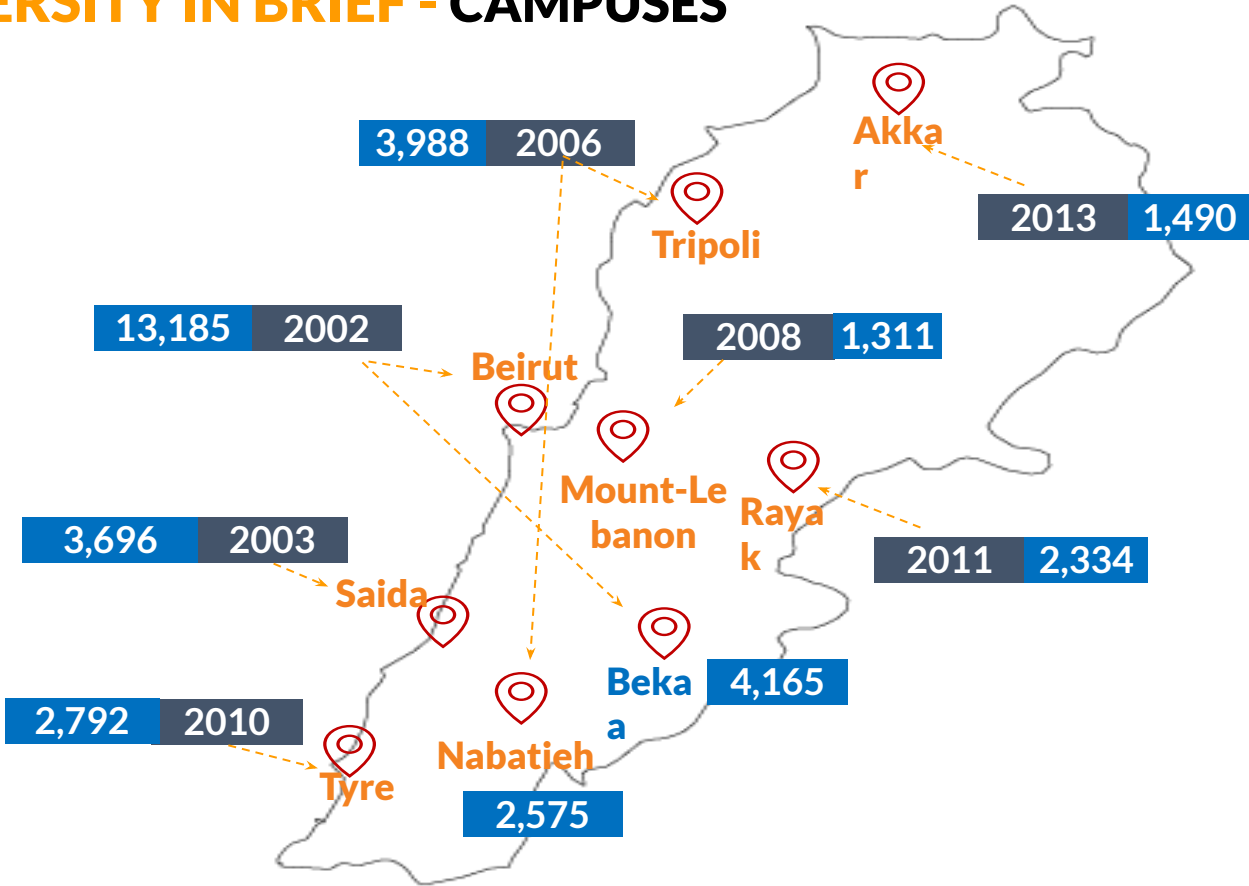
## LIU VISION

## SoED Outreach Programs



**Lifelong learning** is the broad term for education that is conducted beyond a class and also known as **soft skills**. Therefore it's voluntary rather than compulsory, and is completely self-motivated – with the main goal being to improve personal or professional development. Lifelong learning can be conducted in a variety of ways, whether it's through formal teaching embedded in the syllabus, or something far less structured like training. Even our daily interactions with our students, and the knowledge and behaviors students learn both inside and outside of class, can be classified as lifelong learning. Some examples of lifelong learning include:

- Internships and apprenticeships: **School of Education do Practicum I and II**
- Teaching yourself a new language: **New Language courses are offered by School of Education**
- Studying a new subject: **HUMAN200 Community Service**
- Learning to use new pieces of technology: **Most courses in the School of Education at undergraduate and Graduate levels utilize Google Classroom.**
