



## STUDY PROGRAMME 3<sup>RD</sup> CYCLE KNOWLEDGE MANAGEMENT

**TYPE OF STUDY PROGRAMME:** doctoral study programme

**CYCLE:** 3<sup>rd</sup> cycle

**STUDY DURATION:** 3 years

**ACADEMIC TITLE:** doktorica znanosti / doktor znanosti

**MAIN FIELDS OF STUDY:** Business and administration, ISCED 34, KLASIUS-P 0488

**LEVEL OF QUALIFICATION:** EQF: 8, EHEQF: Third cycle

**MODE OF STUDY:** part time

**CONDITIONS FOR ENROLMENT TO A HIGHER YEAR:** From 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> year: 45 ECTS. From 2<sup>nd</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> year: 60 ECTS from 1<sup>st</sup> year and 30 ECTS from 2<sup>nd</sup> year.

### ENROLMENT REQUIREMENTS:

In the doctoral studies can enrol everyone who finished a/an:

- study program on the 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle,
- undergraduate university study programme (before Higher Education Act 2004),
- study program which is evaluated with 300 ECTS for a period of 5 years (Single masters study program),
- study program for acquiring specialization and has previously finished a higher education professional program (before Higher Education Act 2004),
- master's degree or specialisation after completing a study program for a university degree (before Higher Education Act 2004),
- equal education abroad. The equality of the previous education is determined by the Commission.

For the candidates in the fourth indent, the Commission of the ISSBS determines study commitments in the range of 30 – 60 ECTS which they have to accomplish before the enrolment. For the candidates in the fifth indent, 60 ECTS are given to recognition according to law. Candidates can be enrolled in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year according to the available places and the achievement of the conditions for promotion from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 2<sup>nd</sup> year in accordance with The criteria for transfers between study programs. More detailed enrolment provisions are determined by invitation to tender.

If a decision about enrolment restrictions will be taken, the candidates will be chosen according to:

- preliminary achievements of candidates (the average grade of study, assessment of the diploma / master's thesis) – 25%
- preliminary scientific research (research, articles, etc.) – 25%
- an interview with the candidate – 50%
