TWO UNDERGRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMMES REDESIGNED

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL ON INNOVATION IN ENTREPRENEURSHIP

In September, we organised a 10-day international summer school entitled **Green Innovative Moving Entrepreneurship**.

Together with students and professors from partner institutions from Portugal, Germany, Romania and Poland, ISSBS students developed business ideas for sustainable mobility for a local company NewBike kolesa. 19 students from 5 countries took part in the programme.



ERASMUS MOBILITIES CONTRIBUTE TO STRENGTHENING INTERNATIONALITY

Erasmus mobilities for students and staff contribute to the internationalisation of the Faculty. Within this academic year, we have organised mobilities to Germany, Austria, Jordan, Portugal and Thailand. ISSBS students are actively involved as researchers, analysing and developing proposals for waste management.
